**Program Effectiveness Data**

The following is the most current program effectiveness data. Our programmatic accreditation agency is the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA). The Dental Hygiene Program meets all accreditation standards per the date of the most recent site visit, April 2022. The next site visit will be in 2029. Successful completion of the program qualifies graduates to take the three components of licensing exams and to then apply for licensure as a registered dental hygienist through the State Board of Dentistry. When the candidate successfully completes the required examinations, a license is issued.

**Credentialing Examinations:** The program goal is for students to pass the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination (NBDHE) within the first year of graduation at  $\geq 75\%$ . Additionally, students must pass two parts of the the ADEX dental hygiene examinations: Computer Simulated Clinical Exercise OSCE (CSCE) and Simulated Patient Treatment Clinical Examination (SPTCE) at  $\geq 75\%$ .
